

**Bishop Swim Team**  
**Short Course Invitational**  
**June 20, 21, 22, 2008**

- Sanction:** Held under USA / Pacific Swimming Sanction Number: **0678**
- Location:** Bishop City Pool, 688 North Main St. Bishop, CA.
- Course:** 25 yard outdoor heated pool. Electronic Timing. Up to 7 Keifer competition lanes: 1 warm-up/cool down lane.
- Time:** *Friday Afternoon Session:* Begins at 5:00pm Warm-ups from 4:00 – 4:45pm *Morning Session:* begins at 8:30am each day. Warm-ups from 7:00– 8:15 am. *Afternoon Session:* begins no earlier than 12:00 each day. Warm-ups for the afternoon session will begin immediately after the morning session concludes.
- Rules:** Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect and posted at the Clerk-of-Course. All events are timed finals. All swimmers ages 12 and under should complete competition within four hours. **Swimmers may compete in 2 individual events on Friday and up to 5 individual events on Saturday and Sunday but cannot exceed 10 events for the meet. Swimmers entered in the 500 free and the 1000 free must supply their own counters and timers. The 500 free and the 1000 free will be swum slowest to fastest.** All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming (USA-S) membership cards in a visible manner. If necessary the Meet Referee with concurrence of the Meet Director may require a scratch down to 3 events. An immediate refund will be made for any mandatory scratches. The meet is limited to the first 300 swimmers entered in each session.
- Restrictions:** Smoking and the use of tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in any spectator areas, and in all areas used by swimmers, during the meet and warm-up periods. The sale of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- Eligibility:** Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as they are shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded by mail. ***Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against a computer database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures.*** Swimmers 19 years of age and older may participate in 13-OVER events but will not receive awards or score points. **Disabled swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.**
- Check-In:** The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check-in for all events shall be no more than 30 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. Swimmers who do not check-in will not be allowed to compete in the event.
- Scratches:** Any swimmer who has checked in for an individual event and fails to swim that event will be barred from competing in the next individual event in which the swimmer is entered in this meet. The penalty will not apply if the swimmer scratches before the event is seeded or if the Referee accepts proof that the failure was caused by illness, injury or other circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.
- Entries:** **TWO OPTIONS FOR MEET ENTRY**  
**Option 1: Online Meet Entries** Enter at <http://swimconnection.com/pc/meet/bst> to receive immediate confirmation of acceptance via email. The “billing information” email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. Online entry requires payment by credit card using our secure site. The cost of using Online Meet Entries is \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total entry

fees. Please note that the processing fee is separate fee from the entry fees. Online meet entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Fees collected by the use of this system are completely voluntary. Online meet entry is no way required or expected of a swimmer by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will close at midnight on Wednesday the 11th of June.

**Option 2: Traditional Mailed Entries:** Entries must be on attached SAMMS Consolidated Entry Card. Entry cards must be completely filled out including best short course times for each event. Entered times must be submitted in yards. "No Times" will be accepted. Local Hand deliveries of entries will be accepted at the pool, by the BST Coaching staff until 7:00 pm on Wednesday June 11th. Entries should be postmarked no later than Monday, June 9, 2008.

No late entries will be accepted. No deck entries will be accepted. No refunds will be made except for mandatory scratchdowns. Relay entries will be accepted at an announced time.

**Entry Fee:** \$2.25 per event. \$7.00 per relay entry. \$5.00 swimmer participation fee per swimmer to help cover meet expenses. Make checks payable to **Bishop Swim Team** and mail entries to:

**Awards:** *Individual Ages will be awarded as:* 6 & Under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, & 18 -The 6 & Un, 7, and 8 ages will swim together in an 8&U age group but will be awarded separately. - The 9 and 10 ages will swim together as a 9-10 age group but will be awarded separately. -The 11 and 12 ages will swim together as an 11-12 age group but will be awarded separately. - The 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, & 18 ages will swim together as a 13-ovr age group but will be awarded separately. Friday evening's "18 & Un" events will be awarded separately as the above listed ages, but swum together by the individual seed times.

For individual events: Medal awards will be given for 1st through 3rd place. Ribbon awards will be given for 4th through 10th place.

*Age groups for relays will be:* 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-18. These age group relays will be swum in the appropriate event number, seeded by entry time but awarded separately as the previously listed single age groups.

For relay events: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place

**Scoring:** Individual events will be scored for 1st through 6th place as follows: 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
