

# Morgan Hill Swim Club Age Group Open Meet September 4-5, 2010

**SANCTION:** Held under USA Swimming/Pacific Swimming sanction number: **10-116**

**LOCATION:** Morgan Hill Aquatics Center, 16200 Condit Road, Morgan Hill, CA.

**From Southbound Highway 101:** take Dunne Avenue exit, go left and cross over 101, go right at first street (traffic light), Condit Road. Pool is on left, about ¼ mile.

**From Northbound Highway 101:** take Tennant Avenue exit, go right and make immediate left onto Condit Road. Pool is on right.

**PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE WEST SIDE OF CONDIT. YOU WILL BE TOWED.**

**Entry:** Enter facility through the gates at the competition end of the Aquatics Center, the south end. The facility may also be entered through the main entrance on the north end.

**COURSE:** 25 yard x 50-meter outdoor, heated pool, minimum depth 7-13 feet is in accordance with Article 103.2.3. we will swim up to 16 lanes (25 yards) depending on the number entries. Warm-up / warm-down lanes will be available. In accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4) the competition course has been certified. A copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming.

**RACING STARTS:** Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**FACILITY:** Locker rooms with showers are available.

**TIMES:** Competition begins at 9:00 AM, each day; warm-ups will be from 7:30 – 8:45 AM.

**RULES:** Current USA Swimming, and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course. All events are timed finals. **Swimmers may compete in up to four events per day.** All swimmers ages 12 and under should complete competition within four hours. Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated time line, per the "Four-Hour Rule," based on the swimmers age and gender. If local conditions warrant it, the Meet Referee, with concurrence of the Meet Director, may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches. **All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner**

**RESTRICTIONS:**

- Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in locker rooms, in spectator seating or standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers during the meet and during warm-up periods.
- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No propane containers, other than provided for the snack bar, are allowed in any areas of the meet venue.
- No pets allowed in all areas of the meet venue.
- No glass containers allowed in all areas of the meet venue.
- Team areas are located on lawn and areas around the competition pool. Limited areas for coaches are next to the pool. No EZ-ups or chairs provided.
- Cement walkways are to be left open for emergency vehicle access and/or traffic flow.

- The Morgan Hill Aquatics Center prohibits any outside commercial food from being brought into the swim venue. (Picnic tables are located outside the gate.)

**ELIGIBILITY:** Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and enter their name and registration number on the meet entry card as shown on their Registration Card. All swimmers registration will be checked against the SWIMS database. If a swimmer is not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet. A \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee. Disabled swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy. Swimmers 19 years of age and over may compete in the meet for time only, no awards (17-18 age group time standards apply).

**CHECK-IN:** The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check-in for all individual events shall be no more than 30 minutes before the *estimated* time of the start of the first heat of the event. Swimmers who do not check in will not be seeded and will not be allowed to compete in that event.

**ENTRIES:** **Entries must be on attached form or online.** Individual entries must be filled out completely, including best short course yards time for each event, and accompanied by a check for the correct amount. Entry times submitted in this meet will be checked against a computer data base and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming entry time verification procedures.

**ONLINE ENTRIES:** You may enter this meet online or by mail. Enter at: to receive an immediate entry confirmation. The “billing information” email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. This method requires payment by credit card using our secure site. Swim Connection LLC charges a processing fee for this service, equal to \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total meet Entry Fees. Online meet Entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees. If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering on line is a convenience and is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected in order to enter this meet. **Online entries will not be accepted after August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2009.** <http://ome.swimconnection.com/pc/mako20100904>

**ENTRY DEADLINE:** Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday, August 24, 2009, entered online by midnight, Wednesday, August 26, 2009, or hand delivered to the address below no later than Wednesday, August 26, 2009, 8:00 P.M. No late entries, no telephone entries, and no FAXED entries will be accepted.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$ 2.75 per individual event, plus \$5.00 participation fee per swimmer.

**RELAY FEES:** \$ 9.00 per relay team. Relay entries will be due on the day of the meet, at a time to be announced at the beginning of the meet, and will be deck seeded. Payment is due at the time of entry. 49'er relay teams are a combination of four (4) girls and boys whose ages total forty-nine or less.

**FLIGHT:** Each event having more than 24 swimmers check in will be swum in two equal flights, with the faster half making up the **Gold Flight**, and the slower half the **Silver Flight**. Swimmers with identical entry times on either side of the division, or the middle swimmer in an event with an uneven number of entries, will be seeded into the **Gold Flight**.

**AWARDS:** A distinctive award will be provided to each swimmer in each event earning first through eighth places at two levels, **Gold and Silver Flights**. 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place relay team swimmers will be awarded. Swimmers aged 6/under will be awarded and scored separately from 8/under swimmers. Swimmers aged 13-14 will be awarded and scored separately from 15-18 swimmers. High Point trophies will be awarded to the first place girl and boy in each age group. Scores earned in **Silver Flight** will not earn points toward High Point trophies. Team Trophies will be awarded for first through eighth place finishers at the conclusion of the meet. Individuals in **Gold Flight** score 19, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, and 11 points for 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place. No awards will be mailed.

**TIMERS:** Each team is requested to provide timers based on each team's total number of swimmers for each day. Lane assignments will be given to each participating team several days prior to the meet.

**GENERAL:** Admission is free. A two-day program will be available for a fee. Hospitality will be provided for timers/recorders, coaches, and meet officials. A full service snack bar will be available.

**PARKING:** NO OVERNIGHT OR RV PARKING IS PERMITTED. Please note signs and avoid parking in restricted areas.
