

Pacific Swimming 14-Under Junior Olympic Championships

By entering the meet, the athlete or his/her guardian consents to this publication.

USE OF AUDIO AND VIDEO: Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone camera, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms

LOCATION: Morgan Hill Aquatics Center, 16200 Condit Road, Morgan Hill, CA.
From Southbound Highway 101: take Dunne Avenue exit, go left and cross over 101, go right at the first street (traffic light), Condit Road. Pool is on left, about ¼ mile.
From Northbound Highway 101: take Tennant Avenue exit, go right and make immediate left onto Condit Road. Pool is on right.
Entry: Enter facility through the gates at the competition end of the Aquatics Center, the south end. The facility may also be entered through the main entrance on the north end.

PARKING: Parking is allowed on the lot to the NORTH of the facility, in the main paved lot and the lot adjacent to the soccer fields. Also, parking will be allowed on the SOUTH side of the facility in the grass/gravel lot. Street parking is allowed on the EAST side of Conduit Avenue. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK ON THE WEST SIDE OF CONDIT. YOU WILL BE TOWED. ALSO, DO NOT PARK IN THE LOTS FOR HARLEY DAVIDSON OR PATIO WORLD. YOU WILL BE TOWED AT YOUR EXPENSE.** Secure your vehicle at all times. The City of Morgan Hill and the Morgan Hill Makos take no responsibility for your vehicles or the contents within.

COURSE: 25 yard x 50-meter outdoor, heated pool, minimum depth 7-13 feet is in accordance with Article 103.2.3. we will swim up to 16 lanes (25 yards) depending on the number entries. Warm-up / warm-down lanes will be available. In accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4) the competition course has been certified. A copy of the certification is on file with USA Swimming.

UNACCOMPANIED SWIMMERS: Any USAS athlete-member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming member-coach for the purposes of athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a coach-member of the athlete's USAS Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA Swimming member-coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the athlete's USAS Club Member-Coach. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

TENTS: Warming/heated tents will be provided so that **swimmers** have a warm environment during the meet. Space will be very limited, no saving of space within the tents. No large chairs or large coolers are allowed within the tents. **Meet management will restrict access and use of the tents to swimmers only.** Tents will be on deck near the competition area. You may place plastic tarps/blankets/sleeping bags on the deck to act as insulation. All other team tents are welcome around the facility (inside). You may leave ez-ups up overnight, however the Morgan Hill Makos nor the City of Morgan Hill take no responsibility for personal belongings. Covered areas for coaches and timing will be provided along the perimeter of the pool.

TIMES: Competition begins at 9:00 AM, each day; warm-ups will begin at 7:30am each morning and end at 8:45am. Finals will begin no sooner than one hour after completion of the last preliminary event. The exact time will be determined by the referee and announced as early as possible.

RULES: Current USA Swimming, and Pacific Swimming rules will govern the meet. Pacific Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course. Swimmers may swim in THREE (3) events per day plus relays. Relays and 11-12/13-14 age group 1000 yards and 1650 yard Freestyle will be timed finals (see special rules below) All other events are trials and Championship and Consolation Finals. *All coaches and deck officials must wear their USA Swimming membership cards in a visible manner.*

SPECIAL RULES: All HEATS of the 11-12 and 13-14 age group 1000 yard and 1650 yard Freestyle events will swim together fastest to slowest alternating between girls and boys at the conclusion of the trials on the day the event are scheduled. Swimmers **MUST** provide their own timers and lap counters for the 1000 yard and 1650 yard Freestyle races.

ELIGIBILITY: This meet is open to swimmers aged 14 years and younger who are registered in the Pacific Swimming LSC and have achieved the Junior Olympic Pacific Swimming time standard in each event entered as listed in the 2011 Swim Guide. Swimmers must be current members of USA-S and must enter their name and registration on the meet entry card, or online as shown on their Registration Card. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the swimmer with the registration and times database. The meet host must check all swimmer registration against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, the Meet Director shall accept the registration at the meet (a \$10 surcharge will be added to the regular registration fee). Duplicate registrations will be refunded via mail POST MEET. Disabled swimmers are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding any special accommodations requested on the entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming Policy.

11-12 MOTIVATIONAL CAMP

This camp will be held in February or March 2012. Forty-eight swimmers will be selected from the Short Course Junior Olympic Championship Meet held in Morgan Hill on December 2-4, 2011. The age of the participants is 11-12 as of the final day of competition at the meet. To apply, the athlete must compete at the December 2011 Short Course Junior Olympic Championship Meet.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in locker rooms, in spectator seating or standing areas and in all areas used by swimmers during the meet and during warm-up periods.
- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No propane containers, other than provided for the snack bar and heating tents that are setup by the Makos, are allowed in any areas of the meet venue. Any containers found will be asked to be removed immediately.
- No pets allowed in all areas of the meet venue. Guide Dogs are exempt.
- No glass containers allowed in all areas of the meet venue.
- Team areas are located on lawn and areas around the recreation side of the pool. Limited areas for coaches are next to the pool. No EZ-ups or chairs provided. Coaches are expected to share areas around the pool deck.
- Cement walkways are to be left open for emergency vehicle access and/or traffic flow.

RELAYS: All relay entries must be submitted by the entry deadline with the entry time listed. Relay entries will not be accepted without an entry time – see qualifying times section. Relays must check in by 12:00 noon each day. Teams not checked in will not be seeded and will not be allowed to compete in the event. Each swimmer's complete name and actual age must be entered on the card at the time of check-in. **Order of swim must be declared prior to the start of the heat.** All relays are swum as timed finals at the conclusion of finals. No late, telephone, or faxed entries will be accepted. NO refunds will be given.

PROOF OF TIMES:

Proof of time will be required in advance for all swimmers in this meet per the Pacific Swimming rule, section 4.C.2. All entry times will be verified against the USA Swimming's SWIMS database. Entry times must have been achieved PRIOR to the closing date of entries for the meet Wednesday, **November 23rd, 2011**. If the time cannot be proven prior to the meet, the swimmer will not be allowed to check in for the event until the entry time has been proven. When possible, the coaches will be notified of their swimmers who have not proven their entry times. No refunds will be given if a time cannot be proven. Converted times are NOT to be used. Time standards for this meet are provided in short course yards, short course meters, and long course meters. A swimmer who has met the qualifying time standard for an event in any course may enter that event at this meet.

SEEDING:

Conforming Short Course yard (SCY)-(JO Times) will be seeded first followed by non-conforming Short Course Meter (SCM)-(JO Times), followed by non-conforming Long Course Meters (LCM)-(JO Times).

CHECK-IN:

The meet will be deck seeded. Swimmers must check-in at the Clerk-of-Course. Close of check-in for all events shall be no more than 60 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of the event. No event shall be closed more than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the event. Swimmers who do not check-in will not be allowed to compete in the event.

SCRATCHES:

The Pacific Swimming Scratch Rules will be in effect. A copy of these rules will be posted at the Clerk-of Course. Briefly, these rules include the following provisions:
Swimmers entered in an individual event in a Trials and Finals meet that is seeded on the deck who have checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless they notify the clerk of the course before seeding for that event has begun that they wish to scratch. Failure to swim an event will result in being barred from rest of his/her events that day including relays. If the swimmer qualified for a final before missing an event they may swim that final.
Any swimmer qualifying for any level of finals in an individual event who does not wish to compete must scratch within 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers. During this period, qualifiers may also notify the referee that they may not intend to compete in consolation finals or finals. In this case they must declare their final intention within 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers following their last individual preliminary event.
Any swimmer originally qualifying for final who fails to compete in that final will be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. If the failure to compete occurs on the last day the swimmer is entered in an individual event in the meet, and no other individual event penalty is applicable, the swimmer shall then be fined \$25.00. Exceptions to that fin are ONLY under the conditions stating in the Pacific Swimming scratch rules.

ENTRIES:

Entries must be on attached form or online. Forms must be completely filled out including best conforming Short Course Yards (SCY) (JO Time), Short Course Meters (SCM) (JO Time), or Long Course Meters (LCM) (JO Time) for each event entered. All entry times shall be noted by (SCY), (SCM), or (LCM) to the right of the entry time. **DO NOT CONVERT TIMES USING ANY CONVERSION FORMULA.** Entry times submitted for this meet will be checked against the SWIMS database and may be changed in accordance with Pacific Swimming Entry Time Verification Procedures. ***“NO TIME” or “NT” entries cannot and will not be accepted.***

ONLINE ENTRIES:

You may enter this meet online or by mail.
Enter at <http://ome.swinconnection.com/pc/mako20111202> to receive an immediate entry confirmation. The “billing information” email should be brought to the meet as proof of entry. This method requires payment by credit card using our secure site. Swim Connection LLC charges a processing fee for this service, equal to \$1 per swimmer plus 5% of the total meet entry fees. Online meet entry fees are paid to Swim Connection LLC. Please note that the processing fee is a separate fee from the entry fees.
ONLINE ENTRIES WILL CLOSE 6pm as of Wednesday November 23rd, 2011. NO refunds will be made except for mandatory scratches.

If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering on line is a convenience and is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected in order to enter this meet. **Online entries will not be accepted after Wednesday November 23rd, 2011.**

ENTRY

DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked by midnight, Monday, November 21st 2011, entered online by 6pm **Wednesday November 23rd, 2011**, or hand delivered to the address below no later than **Wednesday November 23rd, 2011**. *No late entries, no telephone entries, and no FAXED entries will be accepted.*

ENTRY FEES: \$ **5.50** per individual event, plus \$**5.00** participation fee per swimmer. Relay fees are \$20 per entry.

AWARDS: Individual High Point Award will be given for each age group and gender. Distinctive awards will be given to each finalist 1st through 8th place in each event. Consolation finalists will be awarded but not scored. The 11-12 and 13-14 age groups in the 1000 and 1650 Freestyle events will be awarded and scored separately. Team Awards will be provided for finishing 1st through 8th Place. Pick up awards shortly after results have been posted. All awards must be picked up at the meet. No awards will be mailed.

GENERAL: Admission is free. A three-day program will be available for a fee. Hospitality will be provided for timers/recorders, coaches, and meet officials. A full service snack bar will be available. Coaches and officials will be provided meals. Timers will be provided light refreshments, including coffee, light snacks, etc...
