Purpose: To create a uniform no-show rule within Pacific Swimming, to obtain Zone input regarding the current no-show rule and to address senior level meets regarding the rule.

1) Motion to change rule 3.B.5.B(2)

Current - Events Seeded on the Deck — There is no penalty for swimmers not checking in for a particular event; they will simply be scratched from it. There is no penalty for swimmers missing an age group timed final event for which they are checked in. Events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the estimated start of the event.

Change to - There is no penalty for swimmers not checking in for a particular event; they will simply be scratched from it. Events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than 30 minutes prior to the estimated start of the event.

2) Motion to add penalty for no show to Age Group timed finals events.

ADD – 3.B.5.B(2)a - Swimmers entered in an individual event in a C/B/A+ meet that is seeded on the deck who have checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless they notify the clerk of the course before the seeding for that event has begun that they wish to scratch. Failure to swim an event will result in being barred from their next individual event in which a swimmer is entered on that day or the next meet day, whichever is first.

3) 4) Motion to add penalty for no show to Senior 1 (S1) & Senior 3 (S3) timed finals events.

ADD – 3.B.5.B(2)b - Swimmers entered in an individual timed final event in a S1 or S3 classified meet that is seeded on the deck who have checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless they notify the clerk of the course before the seeding for that event has begun that they wish to scratch. Failure to swim an event will result in being barred from their next individual event in which a swimmer is entered on that day or the next meet day, whichever is first.

4) Motion to establish language for no show at trials and finals meets – JO's, Far Westerns, S2 and S4

ADD – 3.B.5.B(2)c - Swimmers entered in an individual event in a Trials and Finals meet that is seeded on the deck who have checked in for that event, must swim in the event unless they notify the clerk of the course before the seeding for that event has begun that they wish to scratch. Failure to swim an event will result in being barred from the rest of his/her events that day including relays. If the swimmer qualified for a final before missing an event they may swim that final.
