PACIFIC SWIMMING RULES and REGULATIONS Section 3 B.5 (3)(i) Scratching from Consolation Finals and Finals: Swimmers qualifying for consolation finals or finals who do not wish to compete MUST scratch within 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers. During this period, qualifiers may also notify the referee that they may not intend to compete in the consolation finals or finals. In this case they must declare their final intention within 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers following their last individual preliminary event.

SECTION 3 B.5 (4) Penalty for No-Show at Finals

- (i) Any swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to show up for said consolation final or final race prior to the deck referee turning over the heat to the starter shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet.
- (ii) If the No-Show occurs on the last day that the swimmer is entered in an individual event in the meet, and no other individual event penalty is applicable, the swimmer shall then be fined \$25.00.
