PACIFIC SWIMMING RULES and REGULATIONS Section 3 B.5 (3)(i) Scratching from Consolation Finals and Finals: Swimmers qualifying for consolation finals or finals who do not wish to compete MUST scratch within 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers. During this period, qualifiers may also notify the referee that they may not intend to compete in consolation finals or finals. In this case they must declare their final intention within 30 minutes after the announcement of qualifiers following their last individual preliminary event.

Section 3 B.5 (4) Penalty for Failure to Compete

- (i) Any swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said consolation final or final shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet.
- (ii) If the failure to compete occurs on the last day that the swimmer is entered in an individual event in the meet, and no other individual event penalty is applicable, the swimmer shall then be fined \$25.00.
