

## Report: Task Force for Pacific's Meet Fee Structures during COVID-19

Report on Pacific Swimming Task Force charged with reviewing fees for Intrasquad, Time Trials and Virtual Meets held during the COVID-19 Pandemic.

RECOMMENDATION: from the Task Force to the Pacific BOD

For the period between now and December 31<sup>st</sup>, suspend the current fee structure for sanctioned intrasquad, time trial or virtual meets. Substitute one of the following two options:

**#1 The team will pay to Pacific a sanction fee of \$35 for a one day meet or \$75 for a multiday meet provided that participating swimmers are not charged any fees to enter the meet. A multi-day meet may last up to seven contiguous days from the first day of the meet.**

or

**#2 The team can charge a flat fee of their choice. The team will pay only 20% of the flat fee to Pacific. A multi-day meet may last up to seven contiguous days from the first day of the meet.**

This policy will be reviewed at the November BOD meeting to determine if it should be extended past December 31<sup>st</sup> because pandemic COVID restrictions continue to preclude the attendance necessary to support our normal (pre-COVID) sized swim meets.
