In regards to the 2015 Spring Diversity Grant funding to the Fort Bragg Aquatics Swim Team, we feel our developmental program has been enhanced and more successful by the funding support.

We targeted the local school district 2nd, 3rd and 4th graders and invited them to join our team. We attracted a total of 22 Outreach students (2 pending), including eleven boys and eleven girls. The demographics include 14 Latino, 7 White and one African/American swimmer.

Each of these Outreach swimmers were provided with FBA team caps and goggles, team T-shirts and some swim meet entry's were paid for. We were able to afford additional swim lane space for the increased number of new swimmers. Each were registered with USA-S with the Diversity Outreach membership program. All the costs were split with grant funds and FBA team funds.

We held internal swim competitions and provided awards for their achievements, which I believe gave them more confidence in their new swimming skills and promoted team spirit.

Our recruitment and advertisement program included developing team fliers and brochures and advertising to the schools and ads in the aquatic facility programs booklet. The fliers and instruction materials were printed in both English and Spanish.

As each new swimmer joined our team, we assessed their skill level and introduced new swim skills to prepare them for our LSC swim meets. Most of these new swimmers did sign up to compete in local meets improving their skills and creating an interest in the sport of swimming. These are some of the criteria we used to determine the success of our outreach developmental program.

Finally, the size of our team has grown which I believe is an additional asset as it shows other local children the possibility of being on a swim team is available, and it increased the awareness of our swim team to the community. The over-all success of our developmental program is observable and measurable due to the financial support of the Diversity Program Funding.
