



Recent Focus & Accomplishments:

- 1) SWIMS 3.0 and OMR: The rollout still continues to be a challenge and there are still many issues that are problems. As I previously stated, we are essentially in one long beta test with SWIMS 3.0 and will probably be in that mode for the next year.
