

Zone 3 Meet Bidding Process

For meets scheduled and hosted within Zone 3

Any club that has NOT held their awarded meet in the previous year is not eligible to bid (unless it has been approved by a majority of the membership).

Bidding Order

Club attendance at Zone 3 meetings from the previous year will determine the bidding order. Clubs with the highest attendance will bid first and continue in descending order. In the event of a tie, random draw will determine bidding order. This order will remain the same for all rounds of bidding, including subsequent meetings.

First Round Bidding

Clubs bidding on meets in the first round must choose from Zone 3 classified meets and adhere to the format. A calendar with all Zone 3 classified meets open for bidding has been e-mailed to all Zone 3 clubs and is also available at the meeting.

Adhering to the Format

For example...a club bidding on a Long Course meet must run a Long Course meet; a club bidding on a C/B/A+ meet must run a C/B/A+ meet.

Second and Third Round Bidding

The second round of bidding begins once all eligible clubs have had a chance to bid. Third round bidding begins once all eligible clubs have had a chance to bid on the second round.

Once bidding on all Zone 3 classified meets is complete, bidding will open to allow clubs to bid on unclassified meets and open weekends.
