7. LSC Report:

- a. New 2012 JO and FW time standards adopted, many are faster, especially for 15-18 age groups. A and B times will be **adjusted yearly for the next 3 years** to eventually align better with JO and FW times. (Could affect our All-star selection criteria.)
- b. Pacific House of Delegates meeting 7:00 p.m. Saturday, November 19, at the San Ramon Marriott. See www.pacswim.org for details. Several important budget and policy votes this year! Each club entitled to a vote. Club representatives must be USA Swimming members, and their names must be on file prior to the meeting with Laurie Benton in the Pacific office.

- c. Margaret Jackson (DDST Meet Director) will be representing Zone 4 on a Pacific Task Force to review and revise the Pacific meet fee structure. Proposal to increase splash fees to \$8 short course and \$10 long-course (**Discussion and input for Margaret**)
- d. Due to budget constraints, Pacific may be sending only one all-star team to a summer all-star meet in 2012. 2012 is the last year that Western Zone age group championships will include 15-18 age groups.

 - Applications will likely be due before State meet, making January meet the last chance for times.
- b. **Zone All-star meet 2013** Zone-4 is host!
 - First Sunday in March.
 - Identify a host team, or host it as a Zone?
 - Identify a Meet Director.
 - Identify a good Group banquet/activity venue in Carson City sufficient for 400 swimmers plus staff. Needs to be away from tobacco smoke!
