Spring JO times unchanged; summer JO times faster because only 1 venue. Summer FW adjusted to current policies, some now slower than AAA, some a little faster. Oct. 18 Exec: much discussion and brainstorming on relief measures for Zone 3 athletes and teams affected by fires. Temporary waivers of some meet entry and timeline rules, etc. Meet registration motions revised to a deadline Monday or 4 days before meet, whichever is earlier; final vote at November BOD meeting.
