Selection process?

- 8 swimmers in each single age group per gender. (2 alternates each age /gender)
- 10 swimmers each gender in the 10 and under age group per gender. (2 alternates)
- Selection is based on Spring Age group champs, the top 8/ 10 high points in each age . If a tie, both swimmers will make camp.

***Swimmers who have attended Pac Coast Allstars or WZ Allstars in the age group they are currently in, cannot be selected.**

- This camp is being sponsored by Pacific Swimming.
- 84+(if ties) Swimmers from the LSC are being selected based on high point swims at the 2026 Spring Pacific Age Group Championships. 8 swimmers from each age category 11,12, 13, 14, and 10 of each gender for the 10 and under age group are being invited to this camp.
- Two in water practices, 1 dryland practice, and special swag. Swimmers will participate in team building exercises, and have learning opportunities in a variety of subjects, with the goal of inspiring them to continue to reach for the highest levels of our sport.

- Selections will be made by Saturday March 28th, and the swimmers selected will be notified Sunday March 29th by 5pm.
- We are asking for a **\$50? non-refundable** deposit by Sunday April 5th to hold a spot. If we don't receive it by then, we will ask the next swimmer in line if they would like to participate.
