Officer's Reports			
Chair	 David Cottam: He thanks all who have helped to see us through these difficult times caused, by the various unusual circumstances we had to deal with this year (COVID19, fires). As we tighten our expenses, and have had a decrease in certain services needed from staff, we have furloughed Jeannette Soe for now. We have passed the new By-Laws required by USA Swimming and will complete full implementation in the Spring of 2021 We are working hard in getting clubs Safe Sport Certified which we feel is a high priority because it supports the safety of our swimmers. We have accomplished great strides in establishing Athletic Representatives in the LSC. 60% of our year-round clubs have an Athlete Rep, with approximately 70 Athletes, and 50% of those just attended the Leadership Conference yesterday and today. This is due to the great efforts of Veronica Hernandez with the assistance of staff. The Budget has been reworked to meet the problems raised by COVID19 We have issued grants totaling approximately \$1 million to assist teams during this COVID 19 crisis. Goals for next year include: getting swimmers back into the water and meets, updating Rules and Regulations, and Policies and Procedures, getting all clubs certified for Safe Sport, and getting Athlete Reps for all Year-Round Team Executive Committee will meet October 21, to investigate whether it would be useful to allow Flex Membership for just this next year, to help deal with the effects of COVID19 on the sport.

Clubs that wish to continue in 2021 will be able to purchase a license under USA Swimming for an annual fee of \$120 (which will have all the benefits they have access to now, the higher business license). Approval Leo Lin, Clint 2nd – Approved 63000 Office Expenses and 70000 Staff Expenses together – Peter McNamara just wanted to point out that we need to look at the fact that those items together (which represent administrative costs) are 120% of our income.
