



PACIFIC SWIMMING STAFF REPORT – 9/14/26

Recent Focus & Accomplishments:

The primary focus of the staff over the last few months has been preparing for the new swimming season and finalizing the events of the fall, like our Board Strategic Planning Session and October Clinic, Athlete Summit and Awards Banquet. Here are the items we have been focusing on for the last few months in addition to the regular routine responsibilities:

- After review and approval, the new updated time standards for 2026-2027 have been published and new meet templates updated and distributed for the new swim year
- Arrangements for staff, athletes, SafeSport and others to attend the USA Swimming Annual Workshop, Western Zones Meeting and House of Delegates meeting in Denver, Colorado on September 23-26, 2026.
- Staff analyzed meet participation data to identify needs and opportunities for improving future meets. Statistics are available for the LSC and each Zone and were shared with the Zone Boards during the September 12 Strategic Planning session.
- Sent a team of All Stars to the Western Zone Age Group Championship. The athletes and team leaders secured first place at the meet, which was held in Boise, ID. This venue experienced severe air quality conditions and despite being a relatively new indoor pool, the many athletes were negatively affected by the local conditions.
- Several staff have been working on coordinating and planning the Awards Banquet, Officials Clinic and Athlete Leadership Summit. The Athlete Committee has decided to have a donation drive for a local community crisis center once again, as well as working on fundraising ideas for the future.
- Updating the new memberships available for 2027 and ensuring the clubs have a smooth transition to the new swim year on September 1.
- Beginning the year end financial review process and audit for fiscal year 2025-2026. These documents will be presented at the February 2027 BOD meeting.

The staff continue to meet every 2 weeks with key directors of the board. The minutes from those meetings, which include detailed information on the work of the staff, can be found in the Staff Meeting Minutes report posted on the Board of Directors or House of Delegates page.

Updates on Upcoming Activities:

- The Grant program for 2026-2027 will be available soon for all clubs to apply.
- House of Delegates being held online tentatively 10/21/2026 via Zoom.
