New Business	Priority Credit Line Loan  Mary Ruddell  1. The Investment Committee has been monitoring the increases in the prime rate and it was determined that the interest rate on the PCL Loan is higher than the return we are receiving on our investments.  2. We have approximately \$700,000 that is liquid (not in investments) so we can easily pay off the \$144,000 left on the PCL Loan. This will save us between \$7,000 to \$10,000 we would pay in interest on the loan, if we kept to present schedule of paying the loan off in May 2024  3. The Investment Committee chose to pay off the loan now, and the execution should happen within a day or two.

	Accounting Practice for Donor Restricted Fund  Mary Ruddell  1. Pacific Swimming has had a Donor Restricted Fund to be used to cover MEFAP expenses.  2. The auditor reports that according to FASB ASC 958 205-45-11 we must exhaust the restricted funds before we can use organizational funds to cover those same MEFAP expenses  3. The auditor has requested that this change should be made starting September 1, 2021.  4. It is projected that the Donor Restricted funds will cover another 4-4.5 years.  5. Once the Donor Restricted funds are exhausted the MEFAP entry fees., will continue to be funded by Pacific Swimming funds.  Finis Goggles  1. Pacific Swimming purchased 125 Smart Goggles (a training device) to be used as am incentive to get coaches to participate in the Coaches Clinic last October. 29 goggles were given out at the clinic, leaving 96 goggles valued at \$14,683.20 including tax.  2. Brainstorming took place at this meeting regarding what to do with the goggles. (Finis will not take the googles back, as we are past the 30 day return date)  3. It was determined that a Task Force should explore possible solutions and make a recommendation to the board.'  4. Veronica Hernandez and Asher Green will head up the task force that will work with Athletes and Coaches to determine the best disposition of the goggles, and report back to the Board, or the Executive	Task Force headed by Veronica Hernandez and Asher Green
