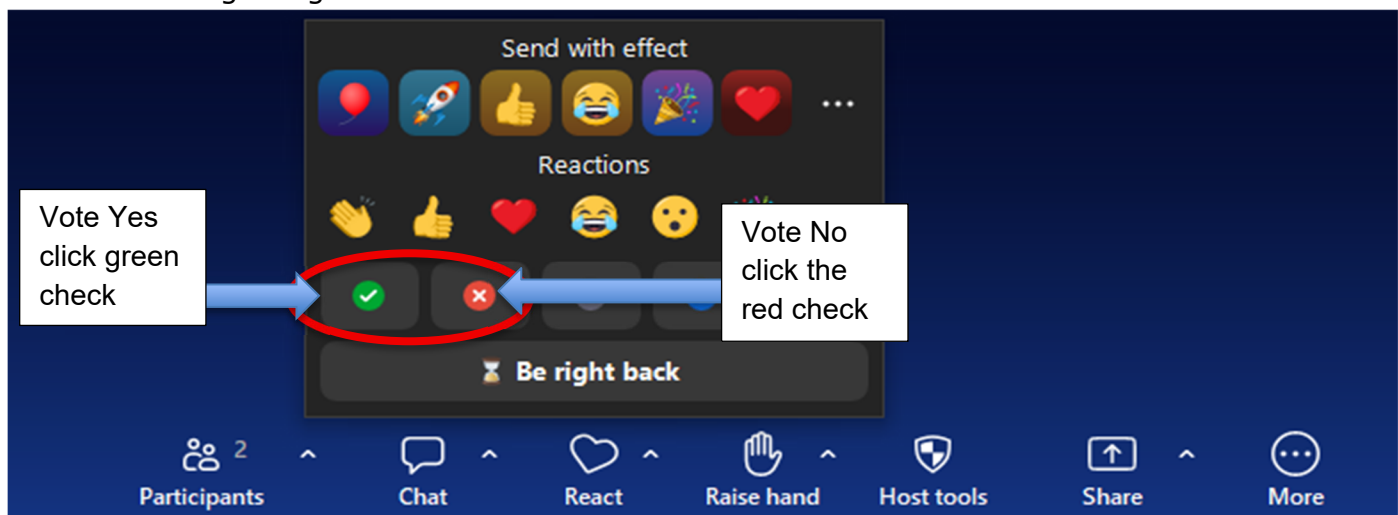


## **2026 Pacific Swimming House of Delegates - Spring Meeting Rules**

- 1) Club Delegates (voting members) shall be indicated by a "D" and a space preceding their full name on the list of participants, along with their club affiliation. Athlete Voting Delegates shall add ATH after their club affiliation. Board of Directors shall be indicated by BOD and not by club affiliation. Non-delegate participants (non-voting members and guests) shall be indicated by a "N" with a space preceding their name.

Athlete Delegate: **D Bella Stamps NBA ATH**  
Board of Director Vote: **D BOD Tyler Long**  
At Large Vote: **D HOD Mike Piccardo**  
Non-Delegate/Guest: **N Holly Gallagher CDST**  
Athlete Non-Delegate: **N Cole Carnazzo PST ATH**

- 2) Participants shall remain on mute to ensure there is no disruptive background noise.  
3) The Meeting Administrators may disconnect or mute a member's connection if it is causing undue interference.  
4) Each member is responsible for their own connection to the meeting; a member's loss of connection or poor connection quality shall not invalidate any action taken at the meeting.  
5) A quorum shall consist of the members present and voting during the meeting.  
6) Any person wishing to address the assembly shall use the "Raise Hand" feature in Zoom. After being recognized by the Meeting Administrator, they shall begin by clearly and slowly stating their name and affiliation.  
7) Votes may be taken by using the "Yes/No" feature in Zoom if required by the rules or ordered by the General Chair. Yes or No can be selected by clicking on React in the Zoom Toolbar and then selecting the green check box for Yes or the red box for No



- 8) When a vote is taken by ballot or by roll call, the General Chair shall describe the specific procedure.  
9) Votes may be taken by unanimous consent.  
10) At any time, the General Chair may authorize a brief and appropriate break to deal with matters of immediate importance.  
11) Any of these rules can be suspended for a particular specified purpose by a majority vote. Any of these rules can be rescinded or amended by a two-thirds vote.
