#### Recurring projects and operations

1. Monthly newsletters published for AG, Senior, and scheduling updates. Created and posted 1-2 days following AG Committee meetings.
2. Working calendar for AG & Senior committees - complete with goals, deadlines for initiating and finishing format discussions, and annual budget.
3. Monthly analysis of CBA meets

#### Data researched completed

1. What is the overlap between AG Champs and Far Westers for 14&U athletes?
  - 51% of 2026 Spring AG Champs athletes competed at 2026 Spring FW.
  - 91% of 2026 Spring FW athletes competed at 2026 Spring AG Champs.
2. July championship meet data
  - ~42.55% of PC athletes competed in at least 1 meet in July/August.
  - Will review against club registration to identify who is under participating and what needs to happen to increase participation
3. 11-12 participation in 1000 and 1650 freestyle is down 34% from Sept 1, 2025-Feb 28, 2026, compared to the same time frame the previous year.
4. A 3-session CBA meet, where 12&U athletes with 2 'B' times or fewer are given their own session on Saturday afternoon, can increase entries for the host club and decrease meet duration, compared to the 2-session Sat/Sun CBA meet with the same number of athletes.

1. 2026 Premium Athletes are down 1095 from 2025 (-7.8%), and down 1374 from our highest year on record (2019, -9.6%)
2. 2026 Seasonal Athletes are down 434 from 2025 (-26.6%), and down 2110 from our highest year on record (2009, -63.7%)
3. Officials registrations have reached 2 of their 3 highest totals over the last 3 years (Great work and Thank you!)
4. Coach registrations have reached their 4 highest totals over the last 4 years.
5. "Olympic Bumps" are diminishing - COVID years not included
6. Athlete retention rate is 62% for the LSC and trending downward; 65% for the nation and trending downward. Our athlete retention is consistently below the national average.
7. Improvement rate has been above the national average for the past 5 seasons (since 2021).
