## Summary of Changes (from 2025 format) + Rationale

<b>Order of events re-arranged from Summer 2025</b>	Each event is offered for all age groups on the same day. Each day (Thurs-Sun) contests 1 distance event, and Fri-Sun contests 1 event fly/bk/breast of each distance (50/100/200) for a more balanced order of events.
<b>50's fly/bk/breast added to 13-14 and 15&amp;O lineup</b>	These are nationally recognized events; PC wants to offer these so athletes have more pathways to achieve higher levels of the sport.
<b>Top heat of 800 and 1500 swum at night</b>	The fastest 8 of each gender choosing to swim in the evening session will swim during finals. This brings more energy and attention to the distance swimmers when they're often swimming without the usual crowd in the afternoon. The 1500 on Thursday PM is integrated into the other events to act as a natural break for those swimming both the 100 free and 200 IM.
