PC Long Course Senior & AG Champs Combined into a dual site meet for July 2027a	Upon receiving meet bids for 2026-27 meets, there were 2 bids submitted for AG Champs and 0 for Senior Champs. Senior champs in July has historically been underattended compared to AG Champs. Combining the 2 meets keeps teams together, rather than splits teams (staffs, families, etc.) between 2 sites
What are the two host sites?	1) Santa Clara Swim Club - Morgan Hill Aquatic Center 2) Santa Rosa Neptunes - Santa Rosa Junior College
How will teams be assigned a location?	Z3 teams will be assigned to the Santa Rosa location and Z1S teams will be assigned to the Morgan Hill location as these facilities reside in each PC Zone, respectively. Z1N, Z2, and Z4 teams will be assigned a location based on 1) geographical location, 2) historical & anticipated attendance, 3) preference, and 4) attached officials.
When will formatting be decided and locations be assigned?	Formatting (order of events, age groups for finals, events offered, max events, etc.) will be decided this August and September after data from the previous 2 summer meets can be tabulated. Team location assignments will be released in September of 2026, giving teams almost a year in advance to prepare for their assigned location.
