HOW TO BECOME A NEW OFFICIAL

If you are interested in becoming a registered Official with Pacific Swimming, please follow the steps below:

- 1. Complete the <u>Pacific Swimming Non-Athlete Registration Form</u> and send it by mail. Cost is \$74, many teams will reimburse their officials for this annual fee. Once the registration form is processed by <u>Pacific Swimming's registrar</u>, you can complete the next steps.
- Create your own USA swimming account <u>here</u>. This is separate from your swimmer's account.
- 3. Complete a Background Check here is a fee for the Background Check.
- 4. Take the Athlete Protection Training here. Free online course.
- Complete Concussion Training <u>here</u>. Free online course.
 Email Concussion Training certificate to <u>laurie@pacswim.org</u>
- 6. Attend a Clinic Contact Zone1S's officials' chairs for an upcoming clinic. *This* step can be done prior to steps 1-5.
- Complete on-deck sessions, shadowing a currently certified official. Contact Zone1S's officials' chairs for more information. This step can be done prior to steps 1-6.
- 8. Take the Stroke and Turn or Admin Official Test here.
