**EQUIPMENT** (Leo) things are coming back fine, no issues. Leo announced that David Cottam donated \$2,550 worth of equipment to Zone 2 – *thank you Dave!* 

MAX 3 EVENTS PER DAY VS 4 PER DAY (Leo) Zone 2 had 20 meets in 2023-2024 season. 3 had no data, 4 already had 3 event limit. Leo used the remaining 13 meets. Analysis shows that if we cap at 3, 10% more athletes can enter the meet. More money for host teams. Charlie asked why not let host teams decide? Why make it a zone requirement? Leo said no zone 2 rule saying we must cap at 4 events. Chris said USA allows up to 6 events per day. Angela said athletes raised concerns at last meeting about safety, too many athletes in warm up pool. Paschalis said the goal is to let swimmers in, meets closing too fast, most swimmers swim only 3 but sign up for 4 just in case, doesn't think safety will be an issue as long as we establish a warm-up schedule. We will discuss again at our Feb meeting.

ZAM (Chris/Charlie) online registration is up and running on our website. Charlie will collect all the times and calculate points from all Z2 meets through end of March. Need to encourage 8U to sign up. Can register online or in-person at Z2 champs. Charlie and Amy will be there. Must swim at least 1 ZAM event at Z2 champs to be considered. ZAM is in May. We will have results by April 1. ACTION ITEM: Chris will send out the link to the form. Charlie will make the link on the website larger and move to top of page. WE NEED COACHES! Chris will confirm if CDST coach lan is willing to head coach. Please talk to your coaches and have them submit application to coach at ZAM. There is a stipend.
