PACIFIC SWIMMING ZONE 1N MEET BID AWARD CRITERIA

Proposed: Friday, May 13, 2016

Zone 1N Scheduling Committee: Noelle Wilhite, Schedule Chair (PASA), Tom McRae (SOLO), Annie Stein (DACA)

- 1. **History of Hosting** Priority given to team who have hosted meets in the past. First consideration for total number of meets hosted throughout entire season; second consideration for specific weekends/time of season. This allows flexibility for teams to change when they host without losing a meet and reducing their total meet count.
- 2. **Team Support at LSC/Zone** Priority given to teams showing support and exceptional volunteerism at the LSC and Zone level.
- 3. **Equitable Distribution of Hosting Opportunities** Share hosting duties equitably among all interested teams. Consideration for financial need.
- 4. **Athlete Opportunities for Competition** Consideration for number of entries available (dependent on number of lanes), additional considerations for warm-up cool down space.
- 5. **Venue Location** Host locations considered on dual venue weekends to reasonably serve athletes in all areas of the Zone.
- 6. **Overall Quality of Meet Experience*** Consideration for revenue generated, adherence to timeline, parking, athlete, coach and spectator seating, locker rooms, officials support, organization of volunteers (timers, officials, marshals, etc), and hospitality.

*Due to subjectivity of Criteria Six, this will be used at a tiebreak. Proposals for objective measures of meet experience/quality welcome.

Additional notes:

- Once the criteria is voted on, the committee will award bids according to the approved criteria.
- 2. Meets and/or venues will not be added to the Zone CBA+ Meet schedule unless approved by the Zone. Non-conforming meets will continue to be the responsibility of host teams and may only be held on dates that do not conflict with the approved Zone schedule.
