ORGANIZATION OF THE EVENT

The event is owned by the U.S. Olympic Committee and managed by a Joint Venture of USA Swimming and the Omaha Sports Commission.

USA SWIMMING

The membership is comprised of swimmers from the age group level to the Olympic Team, as well as coaches and volunteers.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP AREAS

A convenient drop-off and pick-up area is located on the West side of the building on 10th Street and the South side on Capitol Street for cars, taxis, ride-sharing services (ex. Uber, Lyft), limousines and buses. No parking is permitted in this area.

FIRST AID

First Aid locations are located in the Convention Center (Grand Hall just outside Hall C); and Arena (Outside Section 116, Section 101 next to the Bud Zone and Section 205 & Section 221).

ATM LOCATIONS

There are four ATMs. All tickets, concessions and merchandise are Visa exclusive at the event. ATM locations include the Convention Center (Grand Hall outside Hall B); and Arena (Next to Guest Services behind Section 116, Section 126 near the Bud Light Zone and Section 108).

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are not permitted into CenturyLink Center

- No professional cameras (4" or greater)
- No audio/video recording
- No laser pointers
- No outside food or drink (20 oz. or smaller empty clear plastic bottles will be allowed for water)
- No large bags or back packs larger than 14" x 14" x 6"
- No large umbrellas
- Noise making devices of any kind (i.e. bells, whistles, horns, etc.)

- No fireworks
- No illegal drugs and alcohol
- · No weapons of any kind, including lawfully concealed firearms
- · No chains or spikes
- No tablets or selfie-sticks
- · Masks are prohibited and may not be worn at any time while inside the arena
- No drones
- No hover boards
- Any item deemed to compromise public safety

SUNDAY, JULY 3 - FIREWORKS, BBQ & APPLE PIE





that is 50-meters in length and 26-meters wide with 10 lanes (eight used for finals).

This stainless-steel engineering feat takes just over two weeks to build and fill and will be deconstructed after the event. The pool technology will then be transported for permanent pool installations. The competition pool is going to West Fargo (ND) School District for a permanent install and the warm-up pool going to Santa Ynez (CA) Aquatic Community Foundation.

Omega timing and video back-up will be used to ensure the same standards as the Olympic Games.
