1. President Report, Mark Taliaferro

- Pacific Swimming Grant Information:
 - STAGE #1 Pacific Swimming is proving up to \$350k. There are 114 teams (pre-covid19) in Pacific Swimming eligible for grants. The grant was awarded as \$20/swimmer. The prerequisites were that the team must be offering continuing services for its membership, paying staff, in good standing, and Head Coach is in good standing.
 - STAGE #2 Pacific Swimming is providing up to \$350k based on need basis. The prerequisites include the team being in good standing, the head coach being in good standing, Safe Sport Recognized team, and all coaches are USA Swimming certified.
 - STAGE #3 Information on this stage is expected in July. This stage will benefit teams as they reopen and teams that normally host meets.

2. Treasurers Report, Mike Piccardo

- Total \$88,926.29

3. Sanctions, Mike Greymont
