New national legislation S.534, the Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017, requires USA Swimming and its adult members to report suspected child abuse, including sexual abuse, to local or federal law enforcement or to a child-welfare agency designated by the Justice Department within 24 hours. A failure to report is subject to criminal penalties. Additional mandatory reporting requirements apply to USA Swimming members for sexual misconduct, and other related misconduct including retaliation.
