NOTICE: By entering this meet, the athlete or his/her guardian consents to the publication, via electronic, print or other media, information and/or imagery related to their participation at this meet. Such information and imagery may include, but is not limited to, photographs, video, web casting, television, psych sheets and live meet results. **The unofficial results of this meet may be posted in real time on the Meet Mobile app.**

USE OF AUDIO AND VISUAL: Photography and video recording from behind the blocks or starting areas is prohibited unless prior permission is granted by the Meet Referee. Use of any audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to film and digital cameras, cell phones and tablets, and Google Glass is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Referee or his/her designee. Flash photography during the start of a race is prohibited in any location.

LOCATION: Moana Springs Community Aquatics and Fitness Center, 240 W. Moana Ln. Reno, NV 89509

DIRECTIONS: From I-580, take the Moana Lane (exit 32) exit and head west for approximately 1.0 mile. After passing the light on Virginia Street, turn left at the light at Baker Lane, then right at the driveway into the Moana Springs Aquatic Center. Park anywhere in the main parking lot.

COURSE: INDOOR 25 YARD pool with up to 6 lanes available for competition and up to 3 additional lanes for warm-up and cool-down. Colorado Timing System with touchpads and scoreboard will be used. The minimum water depth in the competition course as measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is between 7 and 13 feet at the start end and between 7 and 13 feet at the turn end. The meet host shall ensure the required course dimensions.

TIME: Competition will start at 11:00 am with warm-ups from 10:00 am to 10:45 am.

RULES:

- Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course.
- The local facility guidelines, restrictions, and interpretation of the local public health guidelines shall be followed at this meet.
- All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- All events will be timed finals and will be seeded fastest to slowest. Boys and girls may be seeded together.
- Athletes may compete in a maximum of three (3) events for the meet.
- Athletes must be 13 or older to compete.
- Athletes must provide their own counters for the 500 Free and must provide their own counters and timers for the 1000 free.
- If local conditions warrant it, the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director, may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.
- No refunds will be given (other than in the case of a mandatory scratch down).
- **All Coaches and Officials on deck shall be certified and in good standing. All coaches are required to sign in and present their valid registration before coaching athletes at the meet.**
- Red Cross certified lifeguards, backboards, rescue tubes, automated external defibrillator (AED), and minor first aid supplies will be available.

ATTENTION HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETES: High school athletes in season may need to be Unattached from this meet. It is the athlete's responsibility to be Unattached from this meet. Athletes can un-attach at the meet if necessary. This does not apply to athletes swimming under the rules of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA).

UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETES: Any USA Swimming athlete-member competing at the meet shall be accompanied by a USA Swimming member-coach for the purposes of athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a coach-member of the athlete's USA Swimming Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the athlete or the athlete's legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA Swimming member-coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the athlete in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the athlete's USA Swimming Club Member-Coach.

RACING STARTS: Athletes shall be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start, or shall start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the athlete or the athlete's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited on the pool deck, in the locker rooms, in spectator seating, on standing areas and in all areas used by athletes, during the meet and during warm-up periods.
- Sale and use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in all areas of the meet venue.
- No glass containers are allowed in the meet venue.
- No animals except for physician certified "service assistance" animals. Please be able to show certification to meet officials if requested.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Destructive devices, to include but not limited to, explosive devices and equipment, firearms (open or concealed), blades, knives, mace, stun guns and blunt objects are strictly prohibited in the swimming facility and its surrounding areas. If observed, the Meet Referee or his/her designee may ask that these devices be stored safely away from the public or removed from the facility. Noncompliance may result in the reporting to law enforcement authorities and ejection from the facility. Law enforcement officers (LEO) are exempt per applicable laws.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time Athletes, Coaches, Officials and/or spectators are present.
- **The pool deck is restricted to current valid coaches, athletes, working officials and timers.** Spectator seating is available in the bleachers.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Athletes must be current members of USA Swimming and must enter their name and registration number on their entries exactly as they are shown in their USA Swimming registration. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the athlete with the registration and times database. The meet host will check all athlete registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, athletes shall be required to register online via USA Swimming's online member registration before being allowed to swim in the meet.
- Entries with **"NO TIME" will be accepted.**
- Athletes with a disability are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding any special accommodations per Pacific Swimming policy.
- Athletes shall be age 13 or older. The athlete's age shall be the age of the athlete on the first day of the meet.

ENTRY FEES: ONLINE \$30.00 Flat Fee, **WALK-ON (DECK ENTRIES)** \$40.00 Flat Fee. All fees must be received at time of entry. There are NO REFUNDS except in cases of mandatory scratch-downs. Funds may NOT be applied to events other than the events entered.

MEFAP ENTRY FEES: \$10.00 participation fee. Registered Pacific Swimming Outreach Athletes are eligible for the Meet Entry Fee Assistance Program (MEFAP). For more information on Outreach Qualification:

ONLINE ENTRIES: To enter online go to <http://ome.fastswims.com> to receive an immediate entry confirmation. This method requires payment by credit card. **Please print and bring the entry confirmation email with you as proof of payment.** FastSwims charges a service fee for this service, 6.5% of the total Entry Fees plus \$0.75 per transaction, regardless of number of athletes. If you do not wish to pay the service fee, enter the meet using a mail-in entry form or do a deck entry. **Entering online is a convenience, is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected of an athlete by Pacific Swimming.** Online entries will be accepted through Thursday, May 7, 2026 at 11:59 pm.

DECK ENTRIES: Athletes may enter the meet on deck prior to the meet by turning in a paper entry form and the full payment. Paper entry forms will be available at check-in. We will accept cash or check. **Athletes entering on deck must provide proof of current valid USA-S Registration.** Make checks for deck entries payable to RENO AQUATIC CLUB.

CHECK-IN: This meet will be **deck seeded**. To compete, athletes **must positively check-in** at the Clerk-of-Course for all events that they intend to swim. Timely submission of deck entries at the meet constitutes check-in. Check-in shall be closed no more than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the session.

SCRATCHES AND NO-SHOWS: Any athletes not reporting for or competing in an individual timed final event that they have checked in for shall not be penalized.

AWARDS: None

ADMISSION: Free. No programs will be available.

SNACK BAR AND HOSPITALITY: None

OFFICIALS: All available USA Swimming Member Certified Officials are welcomed and encouraged to work at this meet.
