**NOTICE:** By entering this meet, the Athlete or his/her guardian consents to the publication, via electronic, print or other media, of information and/or imagery related to their participation at this meet. Such information and imagery may include, but is not limited to, photographs, video, web casting, television, psych sheets and live meet results. **The unofficial results of this meet may be posted in real time on the Meet Mobile App.**

**USE OF AUDIO AND VISUAL:** Photography and video recording from behind or beside the blocks or starting areas is prohibited unless prior permission is granted by the Meet Referee. Use of any audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to film and digital cameras, cell phones and tablets, and Google Glass is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms. Violation of this recording prohibition may result in ejection from the swimming pool facility by the Meet Referee or his/her designee. Flash photography during the start of a race is prohibited in any location.

**LOCATION:** Carson Aquatic Facility, 841 N. Roop St., Carson City, NV 89701

**DIRECTIONS:** From Business HWY. 395 go two traffic lights East on Hwy. 50 (E. William St.). Turn right on Roop St, and go one block south. Turn left behind the Carson City Community Center. From Reno on Hwy. 580, take exit 39. Turn right and travel West approximately 1 mile. Turn left into Mills Park and the Carson City Community Center.

**COURSE:** Indoor 25-yard by 50-meter pool with up to 8 lanes available for competition. An additional 25-yard, 6 lane pool may be available for warm-up/cool down throughout the competition. The minimum water depth for the competition course, measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is at least 10 feet at the start end and 4 feet at the turn end. The meet host shall ensure the required course dimensions. All events will start at the start end of the pool, except the 50m events **may** start at the turn end of the pool

**TIME:**

- **FRIDAY SESSION:** Meet will begin at **5:00 PM** with warm-up from **4:00 PM to 4:45 PM**.
- **SATURDAY AND SUNDAY 12 & UNDER:** **8:30 AM** each day with warm-ups from **7:00-8:15 AM** each day.
- **SATURDAY AND SUNDAY 13 & OVER:** warm ups after the conclusion of the morning session, **no earlier than 11:00 AM**, meet will not start before **12:00 PM**.

**RULES:**

- Current USA and Pacific Swimming rules and warm-up procedures will govern the meet. A copy of these procedures will be posted at the Clerk-of-Course.
- The local facilities guidelines, restrictions and interpretation of the local public health guidelines shall be followed at this meet.
- All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- All events are timed-final events and will be seeded fast to slow.
- Athletes may compete in a maximum of 2 events on Friday and 4 individual events per day on Saturday and Sunday.
- All Athletes ages 12 and under should complete competition within four (4) hours.

- Entries will be accepted until the number of splashes exceeds the estimated timeline, per the “Four-Hour Rule,” based on the Athletes age and gender.
- If local conditions warrant it the Meet Referee, with the concurrence of the Meet Director, may require a mandatory scratch down. Immediate cash refunds will be made for any mandatory scratches.
- **All Coaches and Officials must wear their valid USA Swimming membership information in a visible manner. All coaches are required to sign-in and present their valid registration before coaching at the meet.**
- Carson City personnel, including certified lifeguards trained in First Aid/CPR, will be on site and an AED will be available to participants.

**DISTANCE:**

- **Per Zone-4 policy, to be eligible to enter the 1500m freestyle event, an Athlete must have previously established a USA Swimming Motivational “B” time or better in a freestyle event of 500yd/400m or longer, applicable to their age group and competition category on the first day of the meet. Para Athletes entering under this policy must provide documentation of their classification to the Meet Referee no later than the close of entries for the meet.**
- Age groups and genders in the 11 & over 400m freestyle and 1500m freestyle may be seeded together, but will be scored and awarded, if applicable, separately.
- All Athletes in the 1500m freestyle must provide their own timers and lap counters.

**UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETES:** Each USA Swimming Athlete-Member competing at the meet must be accompanied by a USA Swimming Member-Coach for the purposes of Athlete supervision during warm-up, competition and warm-down. If a Coach-Member of the Athlete’s USA Swimming Club does not attend the meet to serve in said supervisory capacity, it is the responsibility of the Athlete or the Athlete’s legal guardian to arrange for supervision by a USA Swimming Member-Coach. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the Athlete in making arrangements for such supervision; however, it is recommended that such arrangements be made in advance of the meet by the Athlete’s USA Swimming Club Member-Coach.

**RACING STARTS:** Athletes must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start the race in the water. It is the responsibility of the Athlete or the Athlete’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

**RESTRICTIONS:** The following prohibitions apply to all areas of the meet venue including the pool deck, locker rooms, spectator seating, standing areas, and all areas used by the Athletes during the meet and during warm-up periods.

- No smoking or use of tobacco products.
- No sale or use of alcoholic beverages.
- No glass containers.
- No propane heaters except for snack bar/meet operations.
- All shelters must be properly secured.
- No animals, except for licensed service animals. Please show certification when asked by meet officials or marshals.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Destructive devices, to include but not limited to, explosive devices and equipment, firearms (open or concealed), blades, knives, mace, stun guns and blunt objects are strictly prohibited in the swimming facility and its surrounding areas. If observed, the Meet Referee or his/her designee may ask that these devices be stored safely away from the public or removed from the facility. Noncompliance may result in the reporting to law enforcement authorities and ejection from the facility. Law enforcement officers (LEO) are exempt per applicable laws.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, Athlete/Coach areas, Spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time Athletes, Coaches, Officials and/or Spectators are present.
- **IMPORTANT:** All floor and wall vents must be kept clear at all times to ensure proper air circulation in the facility.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

- Athletes must be current members of USA Swimming and enter their name and registration number exactly as they are shown in their USA Swimming Registration. If this is not done, it may be difficult to match the Athlete with the registration and times database. The meet host will check all Athlete registrations against the SWIMS database and if not found to be registered, Athletes shall be required to register online via USA Swimming’s online member registration before being allowed to swim in the meet.
- Athletes with a disability are welcome to attend this meet and should contact the Meet Director or Meet Referee regarding any special accommodations on entry times and seeding per Pacific Swimming policy.
- Athletes 19 years or older may compete in the meet.

- The Athlete's age will be the age of the Athlete on the first day of the meet.

**ENTRY TIMES:** Entries must be submitted using the Athlete's best long-course meter time for each event. All entry times must be submitted in meters (converted times allowed). Entries with **"NO TIME" will be ACCEPTED (Exception: see distance rules).**

**ENTRY FEES:** \$4.50 per individual event plus a \$15.00 participation fee and \$15 facility fee per Athlete. Entries will be rejected if payment is not sent at time of request. No refunds will be made, except mandatory scratch downs.

**MEFAP ENTRY FEES:** \$15.00 participation fee. Registered Pacific Swimming Outreach Athletes are eligible for the Meet Entry Fee Assistance Program (MEFAP). For more information on Outreach Qualification:

**ENTRY DEADLINES:** Entries for each session will close by the applicable deadline listed below, **or when a session becomes full and is closed early per the rules section above, whichever is first.** NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. NO DECK ENTRIES OR ENTRY CHANGES WILL BE ALLOWED. Check <http://ome.fastswims.com> for session open or closed status.

**ONLINE ENTRIES:** To enter online go to <http://ome.fastswims.com> to receive an immediate entry confirmation. This method requires payment by credit card. FastSwims charges a service fee for this service, 6.5% of the total Entry Fees plus \$0.75 per transaction, regardless of number of Athletes. Please note that the service fee is a separate fee from the Entry Fees. If you do not wish to pay the processing fee, enter the meet using a mail entry. Entering online is a convenience, is completely voluntary, and is in no way required or expected of an Athlete by Pacific Swimming. Online entries will be accepted through **Wednesday, May 13, 2026 at 11:59 PM, or until the meet has filled, whichever comes first.**

**MAILED OR HAND DELIVERED ENTRIES:** Entries must be on the attached consolidated entry form. Forms must be filled out completely and printed clearly with Athlete's best meter time. Entries must be postmarked no later than 11:59 PM Monday, **May 11, 2026** or hand delivered by 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, **May 13, 2026, and may be rejected if a session is already full.** Requests for confirmation of receipt of mailed entries should include a self-addressed envelope.

**CHECK-IN:**

- **Friday PM Session: Positive check-in.** Friday's session will be deck-seeded. Athletes must check in at the Clerk-of-Course. No event shall be closed more than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the session. Close of check-in for all events on Friday shall be no earlier than 60 minutes before the estimated time of the start of the first heat of that event. Athletes who do not check in for Friday's events will be considered scratched from those events.
- **Saturday and Sunday AM and PM Sessions: Pre-seeded.** Except for the 400m freestyle, Saturday and Sunday's sessions shall be pre-seeded, and Athletes will **NOT** be required to check in. Any Athlete not intending to swim an event is requested to scratch with the Clerk of Course (or via email to [Lindsayrobertson89@gmail.com](mailto:Lindsayrobertson89@gmail.com)) as soon as possible.
- **Sunday 400m Free:** Positive check-in is required by 11:30 AM Sunday morning, otherwise athletes will be considered scratched from this event.

**SCRATCHES & NO-SHOWS:**

- **Scratch Deadlines:** Any Athlete not intending to swim an event is requested to scratch with the Clerk-of-Course (or via email to [Lindsayrobertson89@gmail.com](mailto:Lindsayrobertson89@gmail.com)) as soon as possible. **Sessions will be pre-seeded at the conclusion of the previous day's events. The scratch deadline will be the final event of the previous day.** Email scratches from Athletes will be confirmed with their coach.
- **No-shows:** Any Athlete not reporting for or competing in an individual event shall not be penalized. Athletes who must withdraw from an event after it is seeded are requested to inform the referee immediately.

**AWARDS:**

- Individual Events: Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place for age groups 8 & U, 9-10, and 11-12.
- All awards must be picked up at the meet. No awards will be mailed. Each team is asked to designate a representative to collect awards.

**ADMISSION:** There is no charge for admission.

**SNACK BAR & HOSPITALITY:** A snack bar will be available. Coaches and working Officials will be provided dinner Friday night and breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Hospitality will be available throughout the day.

**MINIMUM OFFICIALS RULE:** All available USA Swimming member certified officials are welcomed and encouraged to work at this meet. As the number of certified officials allows, registered apprentice officials are also welcome to train with working officials. **Participating clubs shall, by the entry deadline, provide to the Meet Director or designee, a list of Officials who have agreed to represent that club for each meet session, in accordance with the following table:**

One half-hour before the scheduled start of each session, the Meet Referee or designee shall conduct an inventory of Officials, and shall compare the number of Athletes against the number of Officials present representing each club. Those clubs who have not provided sufficient Officials shall have all their Athletes treated as “time only” Athletes in all respects for that session, Neither the Athletes nor the club shall be eligible for awards from that session.

**TIMERS:** Clubs will be assigned lanes based on the number of Athletes from each club. Athletes will need to provide their own timers for the 1500m freestyle event.
